Environmental Considerations

The distribution box and its power supply should be placed in dry, ventilated areas away from harmful media such as gas, steam, liquids, or heat sources . Avoid locations prone to impact, vibration, or splashing. Ensure there is enough space around the box for maintenance, typically allowing two people to work safely.

Wiring and Connection

The incoming power wires should connect to the main circuit breaker inside the distribution box, with branch circuits arranged logically (e.g., left-to-right for breakers, right side reserved for future expansion), . Clearly mark the AC, DC, or voltage levels of the power supply to prevent confusion during maintenance . Use insulated wires, secure connections, and proper grounding to ensure safety .

Accessibility and Safety

Install the distribution box at a convenient height (commonly around 1.5 meters) for easy access and inspection . Keep the area free of obstacles, weeds, or stacked items that could hinder operation. Separate power and lighting circuits if combined in the same box to reduce interference and improve safety .
