- o **Weatherproofing:** Ensure boxes are sealed against rain, dust, and extreme temperatures, which are common in Yemen's climate, to prevent corrosion and electrical faults.
- o **Elevated Installation:** Mount boxes on raised platforms to protect against flooding or water accumulation.
- o **Ventilation:** Include proper ventilation to prevent overheating while maintaining protection from dust and debris.

Operational and Community Measures

- o **Regular Maintenance:** Schedule inspections to check for wear, corrosion, or tampering, and replace damaged components promptly .
- o **Community Engagement:** In rural or conflict-affected areas, involve local communities in monitoring and reporting suspicious activity to reduce theft and vandalism.
- o **Labeling and Documentation:** Clearly label boxes with ownership and contact information to discourage unauthorized interference and facilitate rapid response in case of issues.
