These facilities are designed for rapid deployment, high rack densities, and energy-efficient operations, supporting workloads from 100 kW to 300 kW+ per rack (EdgeConneX) .

IP68-rated devices are fully dust-tight and can withstand prolonged immersion in water, making them ideal for edge computing in harsh or outdoor environments. For instance, Advantech's UNO-430-E1A gateway is an IP68/IP69K-rated edge intelligence gateway, providing a watertight enclosure, easy maintenance access, and support for Wi-Fi and 5G/LTE connectivity. This eliminates the need for additional waterproof cabinets and allows standalone deployment in challenging conditions (Advantech) . Integrating IP68-rated hardware into edge data centers ensures reliable operation in extreme environments, such as outdoor industrial sites, remote locations, or areas with high humidity or dust exposure. This complements the modular and scalable design of modern edge facilities, enabling enterprises to deploy AI, IoT, and high-performance computing workloads closer to end users while maintaining operational resilience.
