For monitoring and security camera setups, the top PoE switches in 2026 are the TP-Link TL-SG116P, REOLINK RLA-PS1, and Aruba Instant On 1930, each optimized for different scales and features.

Recommended PoE Switches

1. TP-Link TL-SG116P

- o Use Case: Medium to large camera installations
 - o Ports: 16 Gigabit ports with PoE
 - o PoE Budget: Sufficient for multiple 4K cameras
 - o Features: Managed switch with stable power delivery, fanless design for quiet operation, and PoE Auto Recovery to automatically reboot cameras if they freeze or lose connection .
- ### 2. REOLINK RLA-PS1
- o Use Case: Camera-specific optimization
 - o Ports: Typically 8-16 ports
 - o PoE Budget: Optimized for high-resolution cameras
 - o Features: Extend mode for longer cable runs up to 820 feet, intelligent power management, and reliable long-term operation for surveillance systems .
- ### 3. Aruba Instant On 1930 24-Port
- o Use Case: Small to medium businesses with mixed devices (IP cameras, VoIP phones, access points)
 - o Ports: 24 Gigabit ports with PoE
 - o PoE Budget: Enterprise-grade power management
 - o Features: Cloud-based management, VLAN support, intelligent power allocation, and cost-effective alternative to Cisco switches .
- ### 4. FS IES3100-8TF-P
- o Use Case: Industrial or outdoor camera deployments
 - o Ports: 8 Gigabit PoE+ ports
 - o PoE Budget: 240W total, supports high-power PTZ cameras
 - o Features: IP30-rated steel enclosure, extreme temperature tolerance (-40°C to 75°C), dual DC inputs, ERPS failover, and Layer 2+ features for VLANs and QoS .

Key Considerations for Monitoring

- o PoE Standard: Use PoE+ (802.3at) for 4K cameras or PTZ cameras; PoE++ (802.3bt) is needed for high-power devices like multi-radio access points or cameras with heaters .
- o Port Count: Always choose a switch with at least 2-4 extra ports for future expansion.
- o Power Budget: Ensure the total PoE budget exceeds the combined wattage of all cameras, especially during IR or PTZ operation.
- o Distance & Reliability: Look for switches with extend mode or long-range PoE support if cameras are far

from the switch.

o Management Features: Managed switches with VLANs, QoS, and remote reboot capabilities improve monitoring reliability and network control. For most home or small business monitoring setups, TP-Link TL-SG116P or REOLINK RLA-PS1 provide excellent reliability and camera-specific features. For larger or enterprise environments, Aruba Instant On 1930 or FS IES3100-8TF-P offer advanced management, higher PoE budgets, and industrial-grade durability.
