How Fiber Internet Connects to a Router

This router receives the public IP address from your ISP and creates a private network for your devices . This is the simplest and most common configuration, ensuring stable performance and avoiding IP conflicts.

Using Multiple Routers

It is possible to connect two or more routers to a single fiber connection, but it requires careful configuration . Since the ONT usually provides only one public IP address, directly connecting a second router to the ONT can cause conflicts. The practical approach is to:

- o Connect the first router to the ONT to manage the internet connection.
- o Use the first router to extend the network to a second router, either in bridge mode or as a secondary network segment.
- o Ensure proper IP address management to avoid conflicts and maintain network performance. This setup allows multiple routers to provide Wi-Fi coverage in different areas or create separate networks for specific devices.

Key Considerations

- o Your router must have a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port to handle fiber speeds .
- o Routers designed for DSL or cable may not work directly with fiber without the ONT .
- o Using multiple routers can complicate network management and may require advanced configuration, such as setting one router in access point mode or configuring static IPs .
