SC pigtail heads are fabricated by terminating one end of a fiber with an SC connector while leaving the other end bare for splicing, ensuring precise alignment, low insertion loss, and reliable network performance.

Overview of SC Pigtails

An SC fiber optic pigtail is a short optical fiber with a factory-terminated SC connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other for splicing into a network cable or distribution frame . SC connectors are widely used due to their push-pull design, low insertion loss, and repeatable performance, making them ideal for data centers, FTTx, and telecom applications .

Fabrication Process

1. Fiber Preparation

- o Select the appropriate fiber type (single-mode or multimode) and buffer type (tight buffer 900 um, bare 250 um, or jacketed minicable), .
 - o Strip the fiber jacket carefully using a fiber stripper to expose the bare glass fiber.
 - o Clean the fiber with alcohol wipes to remove any debris or coating residue .
- ### 2. Connector Termination
- o Insert the prepared fiber into the SC connector ferrule.
 - o Align the fiber precisely within the ferrule to ensure low insertion loss and minimal back reflection.
 - o Depending on the method, either mechanical crimping or epoxy curing is used to secure the fiber in the connector .
 - o Polish the connector end using PC, UPC, or APC polish types to achieve the desired optical performance .

3. Splicing Preparation

- o The bare fiber end is cut to the required length and cleaned.
 - o For field deployment, the bare end is ready for fusion splicing or mechanical splicing to the incoming fiber cable .
 - o Fusion splicing involves aligning the fibers in a splicer and melting them together to form a low-loss permanent joint.
 - o Mechanical splicing uses a precision alignment sleeve to hold the fibers in contact, suitable for temporary or quick installations .
- ### 4. Quality Control

- o Test the terminated SC connector for insertion loss, return loss, and physical integrity.
- o Inspect the fiber endface under a microscope to ensure no scratches, chips, or contamination.
- o Factory-fabricated pigtails often undergo batch testing to ensure consistent performance for large-scale deployments .
