

Simple Techniques for Cable Tray Laying

Planning and Route Preparation

Support and Mounting

Cable trays require secure mounting using brackets, clamps, and hangers, spaced according to tray type and load--typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart . Supports must allow for longitudinal movement and expansion, with expansion connectors installed at building joints or long outdoor runs . Elbows and bends should be supported according to NEMA VE 2 standards, and trays must be grounded and bonded at regular intervals to maintain electrical continuity .

Installation Techniques

Trays should be aligned, leveled, and connected using appropriate fittings. For long runs, cable rollers can facilitate smooth cable laying and prevent kinks . Cables should be organized with ties or straps, leaving slack for expansion and future adjustments. Medium voltage cables should be pulled using the conductor, not the insulation, and tension meters should be used to monitor pulling forces . Avoid using trays to support rigging equipment during installation .

Grounding, Bonding, and Safety

Metal trays must be properly grounded with bonding jumpers at expansion joints and at intervals of

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approximately 15 meters . Safety inspections should verify alignment, secure supports, and compliance with electrical codes. Personnel must follow safety induction and wear appropriate protective equipment .

Documentation and Maintenance

Label all cables clearly and maintain updated wiring maps for troubleshooting and audits . Routine inspections should check for corrosion, loose wires, or damaged clamps to ensure long-term reliability . Proper maintenance extends the lifespan of the tray system and ensures safe operation. By following these methods, cable tray systems can be installed efficiently, safely, and in a manner that supports future scalability and maintenance .
