South Sudan is gearing up to commence construction of a 2,400-kilometre fiber-optic cable that will stretch from the Indian Ocean port, through Kenya, and into South Sudan. According to statement issued by the Ministry, the announcement was made by Engineer Thomas Gatkuoth, Undersecretary in the Ministry. In January 2020, Liquid Intelligent Technologies (LIT) completed a 200-kilometer fiber line from the Ugandan border to Juba. Additionally, 630 kilometers of cable have been laid along the Kenya-South Sudan border, with Kenya handling the stretch from Eldoret to the border, and South Sudan. While submarine communications cables are used to connect countries and continents to the Internet, terrestrial fibre optic cables are used to extend this connectivity to landlocked countries or to urban centers within a country that has submarine cable access.
