

Spacing between cable tray and pipe rack uprights

Spacing Standards: Electrical (power) and instrumentation (signal/control) cable trays should maintain a minimum vertical and horizontal distance. Adequate separation not only prevents damage to the cables or pipes but also reduces the risk of fire, electrical failures, or other dangerous conditions that could arise. Electrical and Instrument cable trays must be located on the topmost tier to have a clear separation between piping and cables. This publication is intended as a practical guide for the proper and safe* installation of cable ladder systems, cable tray systems, channel support systems and associated supports. The length between support positions will change depending on the cable design, size, materials and weight. For example, an MDPE sheathed cable will be stiffer and therefore require a greater distance

If the width of rack calculated is more then the arrangement shall be done in multiple layers. Normally, 5 to 6 Mtrs. spacing is kept in between the column of pipe rack.

Pipe racks carry process, utility piping and also include instrument and electrical cable trays as well as equipment mounted over all of these.
