

Specifications and parameters of electrical distribution boxes at construction sites in Myanmar

Article Overview

Electrical distribution boxes at construction sites in Myanmar must comply with MNBC standards, be made of fireproof materials, properly ventilated, and installed at a height of 1.5-1.8 meters with secure mounting and grounding.

Material and Construction Requirements

Distribution boxes should be constructed from iron plates or fireproof insulating materials to ensure ventilation, heat dissipation, rainproofing, and fire resistance. Electrical components inside the box must be mounted on metal or insulating plates, with the metal base electrically connected to the box body for safety. Rubber-insulated cables are recommended for incoming and outgoing lines, with protective rings at the cable entry points.

Size and Mounting

While the MNBC does not specify exact box dimensions, practical guidelines suggest that the bottom edge of the distribution box should be 1.5-1.8 meters above ground for convenient operation and inspection. The box should be firmly fixed using mounting brackets or screws to prevent movement due to vibration or accidental impact.

Electrical Load and Compatibility

The rated value and action settings of the main distribution box must match those of the branch switches to ensure proper load distribution and protection. The cross-sectional area of copper wiring should meet the load current requirements, and all wiring should be clearly labeled and properly insulated.

Safety and Protection

- o Grounding: The metal box, installation board, and appliance casings must be reliably grounded.
- o Leakage Protection: A leakage protector should be installed and tested regularly according to the product manual.
- o Environmental Considerations: Avoid humid, corrosive, or poorly ventilated areas to prevent overheating and equipment damage.

Additional Considerations

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For larger construction sites, distribution boxes may need to accommodate multiple circuits, and the MNBC recommends splitting loads across multiple transformers or providing standby transformers for reliability . Proper spacing and ventilation should be maintained to allow heat dissipation and safe operation. All installation practices should comply with the Myanmar National Building Code 2025 and relevant electrical safety standards .

By following these guidelines, construction sites in Myanmar can ensure that electrical distribution boxes are safe, reliable, and compliant with national standards.
