

Specifications of cable tray threaded hangers

Article Overview

Cable tray threaded hangers are adjustable supports designed to suspend cable trays from ceilings or beams, typically using threaded rods, nuts, and brackets, with load capacities and spacing determined by tray type and span.

Types and Materials

Threaded hangers are commonly used with wire mesh trays, ladder trays, and solid-bottom trays. They consist of:

- o Threaded rods (commonly 1/2"-16 UNC, zinc-plated mild steel) for vertical suspension .
- o Hanger brackets or channel hangers, often made of aluminum or steel, with thicknesses around 1/4" for standard loads .
- o Ceiling or beam attachment hardware, including beam clamps or direct ceiling mounts .

Materials are selected for mechanical strength and corrosion resistance, with options including galvanized steel, stainless steel, or high-resistance finishes for harsh environments .

Load Capacity and Span

- o Load capacity depends on tray type, hanger design, and rod size. For example, a single hanger bracket with a 1/2" threaded rod can support approximately 50 lbs for standard Snap Track trays .
- o Support spacing is critical: supports should be located so that splice joints fall between support points, and the span should not exceed the straight section length of the tray . Typical spacing varies by tray type and load class, as defined in NEMA VE-2 standards .

Installation Guidelines

- o Thread the top nut onto the rod approximately 2.5 inches from the ceiling or beam.
- o Assemble the hanger bracket onto the rod and secure with the bottom nut .
- o Adjust for tray width (commonly 4" or 6" for Snap Track systems) and ensure proper alignment.
- o Attach to ceiling or beam using power tools through bottom access holes or beam clamps .
- o Ensure compliance with applicable standards such as DIN EN 61537 for cable support systems, which covers mechanical loads, environmental conditions, and material requirements .

Additional Considerations

- o Corrosion protection: Use galvanized or stainless steel for industrial or outdoor installations .

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- o Modular compatibility: Hangers should accommodate different tray types and allow on-site adjustments .
- o RoHS compliance: Some hangers meet material restrictions under RoHS directives for environmental safety .

By following these specifications, threaded hangers provide secure, adjustable, and code-compliant support for cable trays in industrial, commercial, and data center environments.
