

Standard Size of Optical Fiber Terminal Box

Optical fiber terminal boxes typically range from compact indoor units around 116 x 81 x 25 mm to larger distribution boxes accommodating multiple splices and connectors.

Typical Dimensions

For small indoor wall-mounted terminal boxes, such as the ORM 1, the dimensions are 116 mm height x 81 mm width x 25 mm depth with an extended cover, and 81 x 81 x 25 mm with a short cover, designed to house 2-4 optical fibers and up to 4 splices or connectors (SC simplex or LC duplex) for indoor use . Larger fiber distribution boxes, used in FTTx or multi-user applications, are designed to accommodate 8 or more fibers, with space for splicing, splitting, and slack storage. These boxes are generally larger to allow easy access and maintenance, though exact dimensions vary by manufacturer .

Design Considerations

- o Material: Typically ABS plastic or weather-resistant materials for durability and environmental protection .
- o Mounting: Indoor boxes are wall-mounted, either surface-mounted or flush-mounted; outdoor boxes may include pole or wall mounting options.
- o Capacity: Small boxes handle 2-4 fibers, while larger boxes can support 8-16 fibers or more, with multiple splice trays.
- o Protection: Ingress protection ratings like IP30 to IP54 and impact protection IK07 are common for indoor units .
- o Connector Compatibility: SC, LC, FC, or ST connectors, simplex or duplex, are supported depending on the box model .
