The cost of substation relay protection depends on relay type, system complexity, engineering, and installation, typically ranging from a few thousand to tens of thousands of dollars per relay and associated services.

Key Cost Components

o Relay Hardware

o Numerical relays (microprocessor-based, multifunctional) are more expensive than electromechanical or static relays due to programmability and advanced features . o Proper relay settings (pickup currents, time delays, instantaneous vs delayed tripping) require detailed system studies and coordination with downstream devices .

o This may involve software tools and simulation, adding \$500-\$2,000 per relay for engineering labor.

o Installation and Commissioning

o Includes mounting relays, wiring CTs/PTs, configuring IEDs, and testing protection schemes.

o Labor costs depend on substation size and complexity, typically \$1,000-\$5,000 per relay, with additional costs for digital substation integration (IEC 61850 communication, SCADA interface), .

o Maintenance and Upgrades

o Periodic testing, firmware updates, and recalibration are ongoing costs. Annual maintenance can range from 5-10% of initial relay cost.

Factors Affecting Total Pricing

o Voltage level: HV relays are more expensive than MV relays.

o Number of relays: Larger substations require multiple relays for feeders, transformers, and lines.
