- o Switch Capacity: Ensure the switch has sufficient switching capacity to handle multiple high-speed connections simultaneously. For example, the TL-SX1008 provides 160Gbps switching capacity, allowing all 8 ports to run at full 10Gb without bottlenecks.
- o Management Features: Unmanaged switches are plug-and-play and ideal for home or small office setups, while managed switches offer VLANs, QoS, and link aggregation, which can optimize performance in enterprise environments.
