

The switch s light is on even though the light module is not plugged in

Article Overview

A switch indicator light can remain on even if the light module is unplugged due to internal switch failure, bypassed wiring, or miswiring in the circuit.

Common Causes

1. Internal Switch Failure The mechanical contacts inside the switch may be stuck in the closed position, completing the circuit internally. This allows current to flow to the switch's indicator light even when no load is connected, making the switch appear "on" continuously . 2. Bypassed or Miswired Circuit Sometimes the switch is wired incorrectly, or the light module is connected directly to a constant power source. In this case, the switch is electrically disconnected from the load it is supposed to control, but the indicator light still receives power through the hot wire . This can happen if the switched leg conductor is not properly connected to the light module. 3. Indicator Light Design Some switches have a small neon or LED indicator that draws minimal current to illuminate. Even without a load, this current can flow through the switch wiring, causing the indicator to glow faintly. This is normal in certain designs but should not be confused with a fully powered circuit .

Safety and Diagnosis

- o Turn off the circuit breaker controlling the switch before inspecting.
- o Use a non-contact voltage tester to confirm the wires are de-energized before touching them .
- o Test the switch by removing it from the wall box and checking continuity with a multimeter. A properly functioning switch should show continuity when "on" and an open circuit when "off" .
- o Inspect wiring connections to ensure the switch is correctly connected to the switched leg conductor and not directly to the hot wire .

Recommended Action

If the switch is faulty or miswired, replace the switch or correct the wiring. If you are unsure or uncomfortable working with electrical circuits, contact a licensed electrician to safely resolve the issue . By addressing internal switch faults and verifying proper wiring, the switch indicator light should function correctly, reflecting the actual status of the connected load.
