A twelve-core single-mode dual-head bundled fiber is a fiber optic assembly with 12 tightly packed single-mode fibers, terminated with connectors at both ends for efficient signal distribution and high-density connections.

Structure and Configuration

A twelve-core single-mode bundled fiber consists of 12 individual single-mode fibers arranged in a compact bundle, often in a circular or linear matrix. Each fiber has a core optimized for single-mode transmission, typically around 9 μm in diameter, allowing for long-distance, low-loss signal propagation. In a dual-head configuration, both ends of the bundle are terminated with connectors, enabling direct connection to terminal equipment or patch panels without additional splicing. The fibers are usually tight-buffered and reinforced with aramid yarn for tensile strength, then enclosed in a PVC or flame-retardant jacket suitable for indoor, plenum, or industrial environments. Some bundles may also be organized as 12-fiber ribbons for easier identification and mass splicing, with each fiber color-coded according to standard schemes.

Applications

- o Telecommunications and data networks for high-density connections between backbone cables and terminal equipment.
- o CATV, LAN, and Gigabit networks where multiple fibers need to be routed efficiently.
