Deeper boxes reduce overcrowding, improve safety, and simplify installation of covers and devices . For residential panels, internal volume is often measured in cubic inches, with 18-30 cubic inches being common for single-gang boxes and larger volumes for multi-gang or junction boxes .

Material and Installation Notes

Plastic and metal boxes often share similar face dimensions, but internal volume and depth options may differ. Always verify local electrical codes and NEC wire-fill guidelines to ensure compliance and safe installation .
