Cost

The price of fiber optic panels varies based on port count, connector type, mounting style, and build quality:

- o Small wall-mount panels (12-24 ports): Typically \$50-\$150.
- o Rack-mount panels (24-48 ports, 1U-2U): Usually \$100-\$300, with high-density or specialized panels costing more.
- o High-end or custom panels: Can exceed \$500, especially for multi-fiber MPO/MTP configurations or panels with advanced cable management and rugged construction . Additional costs may include adapter plates, splice trays, and cable management accessories, which can add \$20-\$100 depending on the configuration.
