- o Basket Tray: Lightweight, open mesh design, often used for data and communication cables.
- o Channel or Trough Tray: Enclosed on the sides, providing moderate protection while maintaining accessibility.

Cables are laid neatly using ties or straps, leaving slack for expansion or future adjustments. Metal trays must be properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards . Routine maintenance includes checking for corrosion, loose fittings, or overfilled sections to ensure long-term reliability.
