Required Wire Length: The National Electrical Code requires at least 6 inches of wire inside. Overloading a small box is a safety risk and could lead to constant breaker trips or system failure. It's always smarter to choose a box that's slightly larger than you think you'll need. A good box should have rust-proof coatings, especially for outdoor or humid. What to do when the wires barely fit in the box? We got them to fit with a lot of fusing, but I'm not sure if that's okay or not. My concern is twofold - that getting all the wiring in there as fiddly and bent to make it fit will.
