Samoa does not have domestic optical cable manufacturing; the country relies on imported fiber optic cables and international suppliers.

Local Context

Samoa's fiber optic infrastructure is primarily supported by the Samoa Submarine Cable Company (SSCC), which operates submarine cable systems such as the Tui-Samoa and Manatua cables to provide high-speed internet and regional connectivity . Additionally, Samoa is connected to global networks through the America Samoa Hawaii (ASH) Cable and the Samoa-American Samoa (SAS) Cable, which link the islands to international telecommunications infrastructure . These systems are critical for internet access and digital services but do not involve local cable manufacturing.

Manufacturing and Supply

Currently, there are no known optical cable manufacturing facilities in Samoa. The country relies on imported fiber optic cables from international manufacturers. Some of the leading global suppliers include:

Local companies or service providers, such as SSCC, handle installation, maintenance, and network management, but the production of optical cables is not currently done domestically . In summary, while Samoa has advanced fiber optic infrastructure and submarine cable connectivity, all optical cable manufacturing is sourced internationally, and there are no local manufacturers on the islands.
